



NYSPI Pre-Approved Change Procedures

While NYSPI requires change notification for changes to systems that may impact multiple users, prior-approval is not required for routine system changes as described below:

Critical Operating System security updates

- This does not include upgrades to newer version of an Operating System
- Hardware driver updates
- Zero day vulnerabilities

Security patches for any of these applications:
